Since it was founded in 1450, the University of Barcelona has worked tirelessly in the pursuit of academic and research excellence, and today it is looked to as a national and international leader in education, science and knowledge. Our work as an institution is grounded in quality and constant innovation. We adapt continuously to global challenges, channelling our commitment to diversity, solidarity and equality to provide solutions to the needs of society.

The UB is currently drafting a new institutional statute. Based on the principles of transparency, flexibility and collaboration, it will provide a contemporary legal framework adapted to the University's present and open to the future, consistent with its role as a creator and disseminator of knowledge and a key figure in social development and transformation.

The range of academic programmes offered by the University of Barcelona attracts more than sixty thousand students each year across the principle areas of knowledge: the humanities, life sciences, social sciences, experimental sciences and engineering. The vitality of university life, with the student firmly at its heart, also gives the institution an important role as a driver of social change.

The UB is the foremost institution in the Catalan university and research system, attracting more than 220 million euros in research funding and with 7,751 scientific publications, while it remains the only Spanish member of the prestigious League of European Research Universities (LERU). It has also

maintained its leading position among Spanish universities in major international rankings: it is in the world top two hundred according to the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) and once again boasts the most internationally influential research community, with more researchers in the Clarivate Analytics list of Highly Cited Researchers than any other Spanish university.



• For the academic year 2024–2025, 17,640 students have chosen the UB as their first option. This represents 31% of first-choice applications in the Catalan public university system. With 10,648 places offered, this puts the demand ratio for places at the UB at 1.7.

- According to the AQU Catalunya study of graduate employment outcomes in 2023, 86.1% of UB bachelor's degree graduates are employed within one year of completing their degree, the figure rising to 90.4% for master's degree graduates.




